



Hometown Ravensburg was the first Nazi city to implement eugenics; Escher Wyss was manufacturing **heavy water for a Nazi nuclear weapon**



THERMAL POWER PLANT WITH MHD GENERATOR




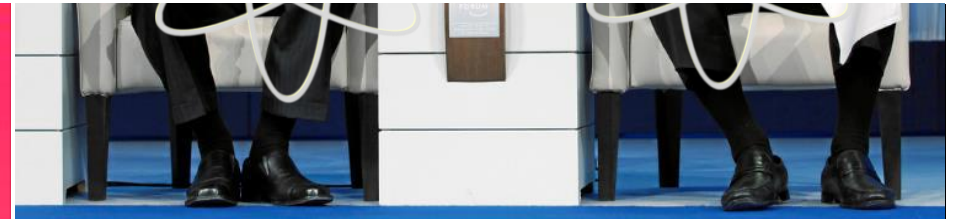
