**Lisbon, 12 November** – EUVABECO actively participated in the pre-conference workshop “Best practices in EU-wide projects contributing to achieving the objectives of EU Health policies,” organized by the European Health and Digital Executive Agency (HaDEA) and the Joint Action on increasing the capacity of National Focal Points (NFP4Health). The pre-conference focused on preventing non-communicable diseases (NCDs), including cancer, and improving vaccination strategies across Europe.



The event brought together policymakers, researchers, and stakeholders to exchange insights on the uptake, transferability, scalability, impact, and sustainability of best practices. He detailed how EUVABECO is developing implementation plans for five innovative tools to strengthen vaccination programs and underscored their potential to enhance public health across the region.

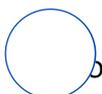
